AFRICA CALEB OUTREACH REPORT

The Caleb Africa Ministry under Director Chibuzor Eze just completed their first outreach to Amaezu in Ohaukwu local government area of Ebonyi state, Nigeria. This is the main battlefield area other than Jos Plains where Boko Haran attacks are occurring regularly. The team included three volunteer Christian doctors, Director Chibuzor Eze and his wife who also is a nurse, as well as hired guards. The team treated 47 patients and gave food to 83 people. Food items included garri, yam, rice, beans and oil.



The team stocked up for the journey with 6 bags of rice, 65 tubers of yam, 5 big bags of onions, cooking oil and cray fish. For medicines



they took pain reliever drugs, anti malaria drugs, Hypertensive drugs and multivitamins. The trip resulted in plans for another trip by the end of 2015 to the battlefield area of Jos Plains, conducted jointly with Divine Care , a non-governmental charity they have partnered with previously. Divine Care operates medical clinics, hospitals and pharmaceutical resources in Nigeria. Caleb Ministries has donated \$1,000 to sponsor this next trip, Pictured left are yam logs in Lagos marketplace from file photo of 2009 trip.

PHILIPPINES JOURNEY 2015

Around midnight January 13th Director Riess will fly out to The Philippines via Taiwan to start his 2015 evangelism trip. The itinerary is available on the Caleb website and as a pdf printout from the site for those who wish to follow the daily travels and pray for Jerry. See www.calebgoodnews.org The itinerary includes villages from Abra to Mindanao with most stops being one or two days at most, preaching three times each day.

Frequently Asked for Items:

Caleb has been asked for the following items by churches and/or villages:

Medications—over-the-counter medications/half used medicines (call Connie Phillips at 206.200.7893 to verify usability).

Clothing—Linens, cloth, light-weight summer clothing, shoes (especially flip-flops), winter clothing, & larger sized clothing. Romania is seeking heavier clothing and donations of food items to minister to the poor .

Baby blankets & quilts

Food—rice, beans, Spam, canned meats of any kind. Velveeta cheese, canned cocoa, and powdered milk

Musical Instruments (small)—accordions, harmonicas, violins, keyboards, etc.

Hygiene items—toothbrushes, scented soap, travel-sized shampoo and toothpaste, and band-aids

Bibles—and books on Scripture, study Bibles.

All forms of school supplies.

KENYA GRANT RECIPIETS

The orphanage in Kenya received our grant in a timely fashion and is now asking for more support. We are referring them to other programs for ongoing aid. Unfortunately, just after the last request we received word one of our Kenya pastors was severely injured. Bishop Benard Onganga who visited us in 2013 was critically injured in a car crash that took the lives of 6 other pastors. He has since recovered but the hospital sought to sell his home and church to pay for their services.

Letter from the Director

For those of you who didn't know, a very fine birthday dinner was held at Westside Foursquare Church on December 12th, which was my 75th birthday. Put together by generous supporters who wish to remain anonymous, the event brought in such gifts as 75 home-baked cookies, 75 marbles, 75 dimes, 75 boxes of crayons, 75 pens and pencils, and even 75 sacks of rice! I am so thankful for these thoughtful gifts and I cannot think of a better way to have commemorated my 75th year! The gifts were shipped with 21 LBC boxes on December 29th or were added to the New Years Eve candy packing party supplies where we assembled 6,000 candy packs being given to children in The Philippines.

Donations, ticket sales and the dessert auction brought in nearly \$4,500.00 which has been applied to our shipping expenses. The Receipts for Caleb Ministry in 2014 were \$58,986.92 and expenses were \$62,073.04 with Grants to church programs or needs overseas of \$15,025.00, Program services overseas (food, medicines bibles, candy pack supplies) \$19,629.83, and shipping expenses of LBC boxes and Romanian Boxes of \$22,606.80. All personnel are volunteers and we continue to operate with wide public support from many fine Christian families and individuals. Caleb Good News Ministries is truly blessed!
